Spelling Bees help promote literacy by allowing children to work towards a specific goal and providing a forum in which children can demonstrate their accomplishments. Spelling Bees also help children improve their spelling, vocabulary, study and public speaking skills and ability to thrive under pressure. BEE-excited with us to include any student interested in participating from your 4th through 8th grade classes in experiencing this classic competition.

The 19th Annual Honey Festival Spelling Bee will be held on November 16th, 2024. The Festival will be from 8:00 am to 2:00pm and include many exciting activities and vendors. The Spelling Bee will start at 11:30am and conclude by 12:45pm. The students will be split into two competitions, first 4th grade through 6th grade and second 7th and 8th grades. All Competitors will need to meet at the main stage area of the Festival by 11:15am.

We are including a suggested study guide list of 100 words (not inclusive of all potential words). Also included are the official spelling Bee rules. We encourage your students to study the words in preparation for the spelling bee. This is a great opportunity for each student to improve their spelling and have fun! The top three winners in each grade band will receive a trophy. In addition, first place finishers in each grade band will receive a gift certificate prize and yearlong recognition as the 19Th Annual Honey Festival Spelling Bee Champion! 19th Annual Westmorland Honey Festival Spelling Bee Rules

- 1. When it is your turn to spell the word, please stand and make your way to the microphone stand at the front of the main staging area.
- 2. When you miss a word, please make your way off the staging area to join the audience.
- 3. It is suggested that the contestant say the word before spelling it and after. However, the contestant will not be disqualified for not saying the word
- 4. No wrong letters may be used in the spelling of a word.
- 5. As long as no wrong letter is used, a contestant may repeat the letters to spell the word correctly.
- 6. The contestant may ask for a definition or for the use of the word in a sentence.
- 7. Capital letters and hyphens must be acknowledged when spelling in order for the word to be correct.
- 8. In terms of a misspelled word, it will be necessary for the last person standing to spell the missed word and one more word to be declared the champion.
- 9. In case a word is misunderstood and spelled in a different tense, as long as that word is spelled correctly, the proctor will give the word again, using a sentence.
